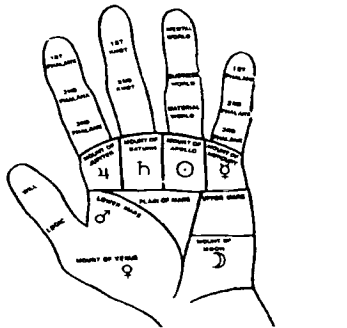

The Tenement Museum kicks off its Thursday Evening hours on June 4th with a discussion of palmistry, past and present, by world renowned hand analyst, Mark Seltman. Seltman will discuss the long and fascinating history of palmistry in New York and show participants how to gain insight into their mental and emotional makeup and the major influences which affect their lives. Seltman will speak at 97 Orchard Street, the Museum's landmarked tenement house and home of a turn-of-the-century palmist, Professor Dora Meltzer. Following the lecture, Seltman will give five minute readings (reservations suggested).

Starting June 4th, the Tenement Museum will be giving tours of its restored apartments, home to 7,000 immigrants between 1863 and 1935, on Thursday evenings from 6:00 to 9:00 PM. Combine a tour with theater and dining on the Lower East Side for a memorable evening.
